14 WHEREAS, Many noteworthy religious and secular organizations 15 are taking part in this year's march from the SAMM Shelter to the 16 Arneson River Theatre; members of the San Antonio peaceCENTER, 17 Unity Church, First Unitarian Universalist Church, and Celebration 18 Circle are joining with other like-minded individuals to 19 demonstrate the importance and effectiveness of nonviolence; and

20 WHEREAS, Guest speakers for this year's event include march 21 leader Arun Gandhi, grandson of famed pacifist Mahatma Gandhi, and 22 Patti Radle, esteemed member of the San Antonio City Council; and
