5 which was created in 1949, Lutheran High North first opened its

7 from the able leadership of three principals, David Sommermeyer,
8 Michael Greve, and Bruce Schaller, as well as the recent addition of
9 headmaster Donald Christian in 2001; and

11 emphasizes academic excellence and encourages participation in
12 co-curricular activities, is poising itself for a future of
13 vigorous growth; in an effort to meet the school's growing needs,
14 plans are already in place to renovate its current building,
15 construct a new auditorium, and increase its staff size; and

17 and staff of Lutheran High North have participated in the noble
18 pursuit of education, and their experiences at the school have
19 firmly set hundreds of young Texans on the path to a bright and
