

R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, February 9, 2005, is a special day at the State  
2 Capitol, where proud residents of Jim Wells County are gathering to  
3 celebrate their region's distinctive contributions to the Lone Star  
4 State; and

5           WHEREAS, Located on the fertile south coastal plains, Jim  
6 Wells County is heir to a long and proud tradition of cattle  
7 ranching, and Alice, the county seat, was a major cattle shipping  
8 center before the turn of the last century; and

9           WHEREAS, In the years since the county's creation in 1911,  
10 the local economy has expanded to encompass gas and oil production  
11 as well as farming, with such important crops as wheat, corn,  
12 cotton, sorghum, and melons, and sunflowers for sunflower oil; and

13           WHEREAS, In addition to its agriculture and commerce, the  
14 county is home to Alice Regional Hospital and CHRISTUS Spohn  
15 Hospital-Alice, and it is important as a health care hub for South  
16 Texas; and

17           WHEREAS, Mindful of the region's colorful history, Jim Wells  
18 residents have sought to preserve and promote their heritage in  
19 museums such as the South Texas Museum and the Tejano R.O.O.T.S.  
20 Hall of Fame Museum, and visitors to these institutions leave them  
21 with a deep appreciation of those attributes that make Jim Wells  
22 unique among Texas counties; now, therefore, be it
