5 WHEREAS, A chapter of the American Academy of Family 6 Physicians and the state's largest medical specialty organization, TAFP promotes and assures the maintenance of high-quality medical 7 care in the Lone Star State; the criteria for the TAFP Physician of 8 the Year Award require that candidates are compassionately 9 dedicated to their patients, active in their communities, and 10 identified as role models in their profession; each year, 11 12 extraordinary family physicians throughout Texas are nominated by 13 their patients, peers, and colleagues for this significant honor; 14 and

WHEREAS, Dr. David Greer treats some of the same patients in 15 Henrietta today that were once in the care of his grandfather, Dr. 16 Albert Greer; a native of Clay County, this beloved small-town 17 physician received his training at The University of Texas Medical 18 Branch at Galveston; after graduating in 1964 and serving his 19 country as a flight surgeon in the U.S. Army, this decorated Vietnam 20 21 War veteran returned to his hometown in 1970 to open his own private practice; and 22

23 WHEREAS, An active member of his community, Dr. Greer has 24 served on the boards of the North Central Texas Medical Foundation,

Clay County Memorial Hospital, Wichita County Medical Society, and 1 2 Wichita Falls Family Practice Residency Association; he is a former 3 president of the North Texas Academy of Family Physicians, and the 4 Henrietta Kiwanis Club and a former director of the Clay County 5 Chamber of Commerce; a previous recipient of the TAFP Award for 6 Advancement of Family Practice in Rural Texas, he has served on the 7 Rural Health Committee of the Texas Medical Association; moreover, 8 he has had a positive impact on countless medical students through his participation in the Senior Preceptorship programs at a number 9 10 of medical schools; and

WHEREAS, While taking care of others, this esteemed gentleman has enjoyed the love and support of his wife, Lea Ann, his children, John and Jan, and his five granddaughters; and

14 WHEREAS, Dr. David Greer's success is due in part to his 15 proven ability to communicate with his patients and listen to their needs; practicing in a small town, his commitment to his patients 16 17 extends beyond the typical doctor-patient relationship; still making occasional house calls and offering regular "curbside 18 consultations," Dr. Greer demonstrates a steadfast dedication to 19 his patients and to his community that makes him a truly deserving 20 21 recipient of this noteworthy award; now, therefore, be it
