19 Research Center board, and the Bush School of Public Service and
20 International Policy board; and

22 and engineering will mark a new chapter for Dwain Mayfield;
23 supported by his wife, Lynda, and their son, David, he will no doubt
24 take pleasure in his many hobbies, which include hunting, skiing,

1 and managing the family farm and ranch; he leaves Lockheed Martin
2 with a legacy of professionalism and a host of colleagues who wish
3 him continued success and happiness; now, therefore, be it
