1           WHEREAS, Family and friends deeply mourn the passing of  
2 Edmund Reynolds Wood of Dallas, who died on December 10, 2004; and

3           WHEREAS, After graduating from Southern Methodist University  
4 and the University of Houston School of Law, Mr. Wood joined his  
5 father's law firm; he earned a reputation for being a talented real  
6 estate trial attorney, serving for many years as general counsel  
7 for Stewart Title Guaranty Company for the Northern Region of  
8 Texas; and

9           WHEREAS, Mr. Wood was active in politics and served as the  
10 first campaign chairman for Senator O. H. "Ike" Harris, championing  
11 him through many reelection campaigns; furthermore, he was  
12 appointed by Governor Dolph Briscoe to the Texas Commission for  
13 Uniform State Laws, which he served for 16 years; and

14           WHEREAS, An energetic and valued member of his community,  
15 Mr. Wood, who was captain of his high school golf team, was a  
16 popular member of the Lakewood Country Club; it was there that he  
17 helped to found the Lady Mustang Golf Tournament; also an excellent  
18 cook, Mr. Wood won a number of blue ribbons for his culinary skills  
19 at the State Fair of Texas; and

20           WHEREAS, Devoted family man, distinguished attorney, and  
21 cherished friend, Edmund Reynolds Wood was known for his genuine  
22 kindness and clever sense of humor; he left an indelible imprint on  
23 the lives of all who were fortunate enough to have known him, and he  
24 will not soon be forgotten; now, therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas  
2   Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Edmund Reynolds Wood  
3   and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his  
4   beloved wife of 39 years, Linda Sharrock Wood; to his two sons,  
5   Barry Burke Wood and Mark Sharrock Wood; and to his other relatives  
6   and many friends; and, be it further

7           RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be  
8   prepared for his family and that when the Texas House of
