2 High School Trojan football team, has earned the distinction of
3 being named to the All-State Academic Football Team by the Texas
4 High School Coaches Association; and

6 high school student-athletes who have demonstrated academic
7 excellence, scored high on standardized college entrance exams, and
8 maintained good standing on the varsity football team; and

10 years, two as a varsity starter; he was named to the All-District
11 30-4A team as second-team quarterback and placekicker as a junior
12 and earned honorable mention at quarterback during his senior
13 season; this outstanding athlete has also excelled in the sports of
14 basketball and track and field; and

16 Latcham has been ranked near the top of his class throughout high
17 school and has remained active in numerous school organizations,
18 such as Key Club, the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, FCCLA, the

20 scholastic performance has earned him a place in *Who's Who Among*
21 *American High School Students* and recognition as a 2004
22 Distinguished Scholar-Athlete Award nominee by the *Corpus Christi*
