WHEREAS, Offered swimming scholarships after his high school graduation, Corporal Gower decided to remain in the Austin area, where he worked and took classes at Austin Community College; and

WHEREAS, In 2004, Justin Gower married Kristin Chapman, whom he had met through mutual friends; in consequence of his military responsibilities, he was able to spend only two weeks with his new wife before departing for boot camp; and
