WHEREAS, The 45 th anniversary of the Johnson County Junior Livestock Show and Youth Fair offers a fitting opportunity to recognize the many positive attributes of this special event; and

WHEREAS, Hundreds of people between the ages of 8 and 18 participate in the livestock show and fair each year; over 1,100 entries in such categories as beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, goats, poultry, and rabbits are submitted in the livestock competition; last year, the livestock auction netted more than \$325,000, with the grand champion steer fetching a hefty $\$ 7,000$; and
