WHEREAS, Born in Houston on October 27, 1974, Staff Sergeant Kimble joined the U.S. Marines at the age of 17 after graduating from M.B. Smiley High School; while stationed at Camp Pendleton, he met Dawanna Jenkins, whom he married on February 2, 1997; a devoted father, he cherished each moment that he spent with his children; and
