

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives takes great
2 pleasure in joining the citizens of El Paso in recognizing February
3 22 and 23, 2005, as Mission Valley Days in Austin; and

4 WHEREAS, The Mission Valley area is central to the rich
5 culture and history of El Paso; the Ysleta Mission and the Socorro
6 Mission, dating from the 15th century, and San Elizario Chapel,
7 established a century later, were placed on the National Register
8 of Historic Places in 1972; and

9 WHEREAS, The area contains many other historic sites, notably
10 the Mission Trail, a section of the fabled Camino Real; this region
11 contributes a unique shopping and dining experience to El Paso; and

12 WHEREAS, The people of Mission Valley are actively working to
