6 Dr. Garcia went on to complete his studies at Baptist Memorial
7 Hospital School of Radiologic Technology in San Antonio, Scott and

9 the Universidad Autonoma de Tamaulipas, Facultad de Medicina, in
10 Matamoros, Mexico; and

11 WHEREAS, An accomplished x-ray and nuclear medicine
12 technician, he has put his talents to work at several medical
13 institutions, including Lutheran General Hospital in San Antonio,
14 Physicians and Surgeons Hospital in Alice, and Brownsville Medical
15 Center; and

16 WHEREAS, Dr. Garcia is also an astute entrepreneur whose
17 business interests include Lando, Inc., Ruben M. Garcia & Sons
18 Funeral Home, R & R Hardware Farm & Ranch Supply, the Lando
19 Beefmasters Partnership, and ZMART Shoes; and

20 WHEREAS, An avid participant in electoral politics, he has
21 lent his experience, expertise, and support to several political
22 campaigns, and beyond the rough-and-tumble world of politics, he is
23 also an aficionado of the sweet science of boxing and has worked as
24 a professional boxing judge; and

2 the World Boxing Organization and the United States Boxing
3 Association, the Jim Wells County Master Planners Association, the
4 Alice Rotary Club, the United Way, and the Alice Boys and Girls
