- 20 Mr. Waller as a man of profound faith who gave unstintingly of his
- 21 time to church boards and committees and who served for many years
- 22 as the church treasurer; and
- WHEREAS, The devoted husband of the former Opal Baird, Mr.
- 24 Waller took great joy and pride in his family; his affection, if
