6 Sophia Hawkins was born on February 25, 1912, to Jim and Mattie
7 Hawkins, and grew up in a close-knit family that included five
8 sisters and four brothers; she attended Central High School and
9 pursued her higher education as a student at the St. Louis School of
10 Nursing; and

11 WHEREAS, She married Nathan Williams, and together they
12 enjoyed a fulfilling marriage until his passing; nurturing and
13 caring toward her loved ones, Mrs. Williams held the respect and
14 affection of her nieces and nephews as well as their children, in
15 whom she took great pride; and

17 conviction throughout her life; a congregant of Pleasant Green
18 Baptist Church in her childhood, she later united with College Hill
