7 of Mexican Americans, Judge Garza was appointed by President John
8 F. Kennedy to the United States District Court's Southern District
9 of Texas in 1961; that historic event opened the doors for Hispanic
10 Americans and other minority groups to play a more prominent role in
11 our nation's legislative and judicial systems; and

WHEREAS, Judge Garza's term on the district court was followed by his appointment to the 5th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals by President Jimmy Carter in 1979; just three years after his appointment, he achieved senior status on the court, and throughout his impressive tenure he continued to build on his reputation as a leader and mentor in the legal community; and

WHEREAS, The son of Mexican immigrants, Reynaldo Garza was born on July 7, 1915, and attended high school in Brownsville; after earning his bachelor's degree from The University of Texas at Austin in 1939, he proudly served in the U.S. Air Force from 1942 to 1945; and

WHEREAS, A true pioneer and a judicial giant in the Rio Grande
Valley and beyond, Judge Garza is remembered by countless friends
