1 WHEREAS, After nearly four decades of sharing their life with 2 one another, Troy and Sarah LaGrone both departed this world in 3 2004, leaving behind a legacy of achievement to be treasured by all 4 who were privileged to know these esteemed Denton civic leaders; 5 and

6 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. LaGrone began their journey together 7 when they married in 1967; he, a fifth-generation Texan, was born 8 and raised in Deadwood, graduated from Carthage High School, and 9 attended Braughon's Business College in Dallas; she, a native of 10 Wills Point, earned her bachelor's degree from Southern Methodist 11 University; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. LaGrone began his extraordinary career with Ben 13 E. Keith Co. as an entry-level clerk; his determination and skill 14 enabled him to rise through the ranks, and he eventually became 15 president of the company; under his leadership, the business became 16 the largest Anheuser-Busch distributor in the nation before his 17 retirement in 2000; and

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. LaGrone took an avid interest in and made a 19 personal commitment to community affairs; she lent her time and 20 talents to the Denton Benefit League, Arts Guild, and Keep Denton 21 Beautiful, and she also served on the city's Parks and Recreation 22 Board; her concern for those less fortunate was evident from her 23 active involvement on the board of Interfaith Ministries, a Denton 24 group that provides assistance to families in need; and

1 WHEREAS, Mr. LaGrone expressed his civic spirit through his 2 participation in the Fort Worth Symphony, the Texas Girls Choir, the Longhorn Council of the Boy Scouts of America, and North Texas 3 4 Public Broadcasting; in addition, he embraced the importance of higher education, organizing the President's Fellows of the 5 6 University of North Texas and chairing the UNT President's Council; he was also a member of the board of directors of the UNT Foundation 7 8 and of the President's Council of Texas Woman's University; and

9 WHEREAS, Together, these respected community leaders 10 generously affirmed their support for public education by endowing 11 two grants to teachers at Denton schools; and

12 WHEREAS, Patrons of the Denton Arts and Jazz Festival since 13 its inception in 1990, they received the Community Arts Recognition 14 Award from the Greater Denton Arts Council in honor of their 15 significant contributions to the city's cultural life; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. LaGrone also valued their Christian 17 faith and were faithful members of the First United Methodist 18 Church in Denton, where they worshiped for more than two decades; 19 and

20 WHEREAS, Throughout their lives, Troy and Sarah LaGrone were 21 known for their thoughtful and caring natures, their generous 22 spirits, and their warm and friendly smiles; remembered with great 23 affection by countless North Texans, they will live on in the hearts 24 of the many people whose lives they touched; now, therefore, be it
