1 WHEREAS, George Wolff of Boerne achieved an impressive
2 success in the sport of horse racing when his horse, Leaving On My
3 Mind, was named the 2004 Texas Horse of the Year in the 2-Year-Old
4 Colt/Gelding class by the Texas Thoroughbred Association; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Wolff has been actively involved in horse racing
6 for more than 30 years; he raises horses on his ranch in Sisterdale,
7 near Boerne, where he keeps five broodmares, and he has owned
8 several stakes winners; he also owns the dam of Leaving On My Mind,
9 Sudden Attraction, who was named 2004 Texas Broodmare of the Year;

11 WHEREAS, The Texas Thoroughbred Association is the largest
12 state breed organization in the country, and it recognizes only six
13 Texas champion racehorses each year; and

14 WHEREAS, Owning a racehorse that is named a champion by the
15 association reflects many years of dedication and contribution to
16 racing and breeding in Texas, and for three decades, George Wolff
17 has nurtured and developed outstanding racehorses; his commitment
18 to the sport is unrivaled, and he is truly deserving of special
19 recognition on this recent achievement; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
21 Legislature hereby congratulate George Wolff on his racehorse being
22 named a 2004 Texas champion by the Texas Thoroughbred Association
23 and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued success in the
24 field of horse racing; and, be it further
