10 Mentoring Program, where he counsels troubled youths at peer  
11 mentoring sessions; he spends numerous hours giving back to the  
12 program and the community, and he has helped to train more than 40  
13 Teen Court volunteers and to expand Teen Court into Alvin and

16 Keystone Club by organizing charity work and neighborhood cleanup  
17 days; and

18           WHEREAS, Ranked as one of the top students at his school, he  
19 is a member of the varsity tennis team, captain of the debate squad,  
20 and a member of the Scholastic Bowl Team and National Honor Society;

22           WHEREAS, This truly noteworthy Texan is dedicated to making a  
23 difference in the lives of his peers; he is a tremendous role model  
24 for others and an exemplary leader; now, therefore, be it
