16 Organization, he also lent his time and talents to the Texas  
17 Restaurant Association, Restauranteros Latinos de Dallas, and the

20 loving and supportive husband of his wife, Theresa, and he took  
21 tremendous pride in their newborn daughter, Helena Marie; and

22           WHEREAS, A man of many interests, from the Dallas Cowboys to  
23 jazz and other music, Mr. Sanchez was known for his amiable nature,  
24 his hearty laugh, and his ability to make others feel special;
