6 graduate of Montwood High School was seriously wounded when a
7 rocket was fired into a group of American soldiers; and

8 WHEREAS, Though he lost a portion of his arm in the attack,
9 Corpsman Ramos did not lose the passion and fortitude with which he
10 served his country; after returning stateside, he took part in the
11 ING New York City Marathon and earned the Avis "We Try Harder" award
12 for perseverance in overcoming obstacles; and

13 WHEREAS, Through his unfaltering devotion to duty, honor, and
14 this nation, Jose Ramos embodies the highest ideals of the United
15 States armed forces, and it is indeed a privilege to join in
16 welcoming him home and recognizing his latest achievement; now,
