11 of the Amigo Air Show in 2004 and, together with her daughter,
12 Christine Gardy, finished first in the Mile High Air Derby, a

15 opened the door for other civic-minded women who will follow in her
16 footsteps, and she may take justifiable pride in her achievements;

20 community as a businesswoman and civic leader and extend to her best
