1 WHEREAS, H. F. Dyer retired as superintendent of Mission
2 Consolidated Independent School District on December 31, 2004, and
3 the occasion provides a fitting opportunity to recognize him for
4 his notable career achievements; and

5 WHEREAS, Mr. Dyer began his career in education in 1977 as an
6 English teacher at Fort Stockton High School; since that time, he
7 has been a counselor, assistant principal, and principal for
8 several school districts in North and West Texas; he was assistant
9 superintendent for Canutillo ISD and superintendent for Sierra
10 Blanca ISD and had served five years as superintendent with Fabens
11 ISD before coming to Mission CISD in the spring of 2000; and

12 WHEREAS, A capable leader and skilled administrator, Mr. Dyer
13 worked for the passage of the \$38 million bond issue in May of 2000,
14 less than a month after being hired; his efforts also contributed to
15 the creation of after school programs and the Values First
16 initiative, and he oversaw the opening of Veterans Memorial High
17 School, Alton Memorial High School, Cavazos Elementary School, and
18 Midkiff Elementary School; and

19 WHEREAS, Jackie Dyer has served Mission CISD with integrity
20 and dedication, earning the lasting respect of all who have been
21 privileged to work with him, and it is a pleasure to honor him for
22 his exemplary tenure; now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
24 Legislature hereby congratulate H. F. "Jackie" Dyer on his
