3 friends of Lena Robertson, who passed away on June 6, 2004, at the
4 age of 90; and

5 WHEREAS, An East Texas native, Mrs. Robertson was born on
6 February 5, 1914, in Goodsprings, and graduated from high school in
7 Henderson; she earned a bachelor's degree from Stephen F. Austin
8 State Teachers College in 1941 and received a master's degree from
9 the same institution in 1949; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. Robertson taught during the 1941-1942 academic
11 year in Sulphur Springs, and in the fall of 1942, in Price, she
12 embarked on a noteworthy career with the Carlisle Independent
13 School District; during her time with Carlisle she taught
14 Representative Chuck Hopson in one of her third-grade classes; and

15 WHEREAS, This esteemed teacher was inducted into Delta Kappa
16 Gamma Society International, an honorary group for women educators;
17 in addition to her dedicated work with hundreds of young students,
18 she served her community through her membership in the Henderson
19 Rebekah Lodge; and

20 WHEREAS, The former Lena Clark married Kermit Leroy Robertson
21 in 1945, and the couple shared much joy until Mr. Robertson's
22 passing in 1988; and

23 WHEREAS, Lena Robertson was a blessing in the lives of
24 countless people, and she will long be fondly remembered by all who

1 treasured her; now, therefore, be it

2 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
3 Legislature hereby pay special tribute to the life of Lena
4 Robertson and extend sincere sympathy to the members of her family:
