

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Gary Hardee, publisher of the *Star-Telegram* in
2 Arlington, has been chosen to receive the Richard Greene Community
3 Service Award from Young Men for Arlington; and

4 WHEREAS, In his capacity as publisher, Mr. Hardee writes
5 editorials and a column, supervises the editorial board, and
6 oversees community relations and marketing operations; during his
7 long association with the paper, he has worked tirelessly to ensure
8 that it serves the good of the Arlington community, providing
9 comprehensive coverage of city news while consistently shining a
10 spotlight on matters of particular significance to area residents;
11 and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Hardee's commitment to his fellow citizens has
13 been further demonstrated through his extensive efforts in behalf
14 of civic organizations and worthy causes; a former advisor to the
15 Arlington African-American Chamber of Commerce, he presently
16 serves on the advisory board of the Tarrant County Asian-American
17 chamber and on the board of directors for both the Arlington chamber
18 and the Arlington Hispanic chamber; and

19 WHEREAS, Other beneficiaries of Mr. Hardee's vision and
20 leadership have been the Arlington Child Care Council, Big
21 Brothers/Big Sisters, the Arlington Life Shelter, Dental Health for
22 Arlington, the Arlington Independent School District Education
23 Foundation, the River Legacy Foundation, and the local chapter of
24 the Society of Professional Journalists; and

1 WHEREAS, Time and again, this distinguished gentleman has
2 been asked to take charge of a critical undertaking: he has
3 directed an Arlington Museum of Art capital campaign to finance
4 \$1.2 million in renovations; chaired the Dream Makers event for The
5 University of Texas at Arlington School of Nursing, an effort that
6 has raised more than \$350,000 for student scholarships; chaired the
7 Boy Scouts of America Longhorn Council fund-raising luncheon,
8 bringing in more than \$60,000; and assisted Helping Restore Ability
9 in securing nearly \$80,000 in pledges; and

10 WHEREAS, The recipient of numerous well-deserved accolades,
11 Mr. Hardee has been honored by the Boys & Girls Clubs of Arlington,
12 Boy Scouts of America Longhorn Council, Junior League of Arlington,
13 Tarrant County Asian-American Chamber of Commerce, Arlington Life
14 Shelter, and Country Day School of Arlington; and

15 WHEREAS, Mr. Hardee was appointed publisher of the Arlington
16 *Star-Telegram* in June 2001, after serving for a year as associate
17 publisher and four years as editor; a graduate of the University of
18 Missouri School of Journalism, he has worked in the Fort Worth
19 office of the *Star-Telegram* and at papers in San Antonio, Dallas,
20 and Jackson, Tennessee, as well as on the staffs of the American
21 Airlines in-flight magazine and the corporate communications
22 department of J. C. Penney Co., Inc.; and

23 WHEREAS, Through his myriad contributions as a newspaper
24 executive and public-spirited citizen, Gary Hardee has touched the
25 lives of countless members of the Arlington community and won the
26 profound respect of those who have been privileged to know and work
27 with him; now, therefore, be it
