6 has earned a medal in each of the three previous Junior Olympics
7 competitions; preparing well for the first year in which he was
8 qualified to participate in two events, he undertook an intensive
9 training regimen and set a new bar for personal accomplishment in
10 2004, taking the gold medal in the discus throw with a throw of 102
11 feet, 6 inches, and breaking the national record and earning the
12 silver medal in the shot put with his throw of 44 feet, 5-3/4
