2 program has been named the best program of its kind in the world by
3 the College Board; and

4 WHEREAS, Comparing schools with more than 1,000 students, the
5 College Board bases its findings on the ratio of students who scored
6 three or higher on a scale of five on the AP physics exam to the
7 population of the entire school; and

8 WHEREAS, In 2004, 93 percent of the school's AP physics
9 students received a score of three or higher, and 21 percent of
10 those Texas students who scored a perfect score of five were from
11 Westlake; led by teachers Mark Misage and Dan Harper, the program
12 includes 196 diligent students; and

13 WHEREAS, These hardworking teachers and students are truly an
14 inspiration to their school, their community, and the Eanes
15 Independent School District, and it is a pleasure to honor them for
