- 3 may end the lives of those who suffer from it; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Parkinson's disease causes diverse symptoms,
- 5 including rigidity, slowness of movement, poor balance, and
- 6 tremors, that lead to an impaired ability to walk, speak, swallow,
- 7 and even breathe, resulting in the tragic combination of an able
- 8 mind and a body that has lost its ability to function; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Currently, there are 1.5 million Americans,
- 10 including many residents of the Lone Star State, who are afflicted
- 11 with this serious malady, and 60,000 more are diagnosed with the
- disease each year; the estimated expenditure in medical treatments,
- 13 disability payments, and lost productivity totals \$25 billion
- 14 annually; and
- WHEREAS, Increased education and research are needed to
- 16 develop more treatments, provide additional support programs and
