1 WHEREAS, Thabiti Olatunji has significantly contributed to
2 making the North Park community a safer place in which to live,
3 work, and raise a family; and

4 WHEREAS, After graduating from The University of Texas at
5 Dallas with a computer science degree in 1987, Mr. Olatunji
6 returned to North Park and became active in the North Park/Love
7 Field Civic League; the following year, he joined Operation Go, a
8 drug awareness initiative organized by African American Men Against
9 Narcotics that stages marches and patrols within the community; in
10 2004, Mr. Olatunji extended his sphere of public service to include
11 serving as president of the North Park Crime Watch, where he has
12 ably led the organization to address many of the crime issues
13 affecting area citizens; and

14 WHEREAS, Thabiti Olatunji is a man of determination and
15 integrity who has worked successfully for the betterment of his
16 community, and his exceptional efforts have made him an inspiration
17 to all who are privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
19 Legislature hereby commend Thabiti Olatunji for his contributions
20 in behalf of the residents of North Park and extend to him sincere
21 best wishes for the future; and, be it further

22 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
