## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Sam Rayburn Library and Museum in Bonham is 2 celebrating its 50th anniversary on December 9, 2005, and this 3 occasion provides an opportunity to take note of the history of this landmark and to honor its esteemed namesake, Speaker Sam Rayburn; 4 5 and 6 WHEREAS, Samuel Taliaferro Rayburn was the longest-serving Speaker of the United States House of Representatives in our 7 nation's history; born near Kingston, Tennessee, in 1882, he moved 8 to Fannin County as a child and attended rural schools before 9 studying law at The University of Texas at Austin; he settled in 10 Bonham, where he practiced law, and served as a member of the Texas 11 12 House of Representatives; in 1913, he was elected to the U.S. 13 Congress and served 24 consecutive terms until his death in 1961; 14 and WHEREAS, In the 1940s, Speaker Rayburn initiated efforts to 15 build a library to house his books, personal papers, and mementos, 16 and soon after, he established a charitable trust, the Sam Rayburn 17 Foundation, to collect sufficient funds for the new building 18 project; an architect from Dallas, Roscoe DeWitt, offered his 19 services as a donation, and the foundation purchased a plot of land 20 21 for \$10,000; groundbreaking ceremonies took place on December 10, 22 1955, and the building was completed in 1957; and 23 WHEREAS, This treasured library is a valuable site of

American history and a lasting tribute to a great political leader;

- 1 the building preserves the materials of the Speaker's 48-year
- 2 political career and includes an exact replica of his office at the
- 3 U.S. Capitol; the museum houses a rare collection of Congressional
- 4 and Presidential papers, artifacts, furnishings, and books; and
- 5 WHEREAS, The Sam Rayburn Library and Museum is a unique
- 6 monument to regional and national politics during the first half of
- 7 the 20th century, and it is most fitting to pay tribute to all those
- 8 who have worked to preserve the building and sustain the legacy of
- 9 its heralded statesman; now, therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
- 11 Legislature hereby honor the Sam Rayburn Library and Museum on the
- 12 occasion of its 50th anniversary and extend sincere best wishes to
- 13 all those involved with this venerable institution for continued
- 14 success in their important work.
