1 WHEREAS, Timothy Daniel Jackson of Boy Scouts of America
2 Troop 5 has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, and this
3 accomplishment truly merits special recognition; and

4 WHEREAS, Receiving the Eagle Scout badge is a significant
5 honor, bestowed on only a fraction of those who enter the scouting
6 movement; in the course of meeting the rank's demanding criteria,
7 Mr. Jackson earned 26 merit badges, including those requiring
8 expertise in such diverse areas as insect study, archery, and space
9 exploration; moreover, he successfully completed an Eagle Scout
10 project that involved securing and erecting a flagpole for the
11 Texas Girls' Choir at Eagle Mountain Lake; and

12 WHEREAS, This fine young Texan has demonstrated outstanding
13 leadership ability throughout his scouting career; in addition to
14 earning the Arrow of Light award, he has served his fellow scouts as
15 venture crew vice president, quartermaster, assistant senior
16 patrol leader, and patrol leader, winning their respect and
17 admiration as he worked toward the highest rank that scouting
18 offers; and

19 WHEREAS, His scouting career has also been highlighted by his
20 10 years of service in the Tejas District Colorguard and
21 participation in three gubernatorial inaugural events and two
22 presidential inaugurations; and

23 WHEREAS, Eagle Scout Jackson's dedication to excellence and
24 his perseverance in the pursuit of his goals have proven him worthy

1 to stand among scouting's elite, and it is most appropriate that he
2 be honored at this time; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
4 Legislature hereby congratulate Timothy Jackson on becoming an
5 Eagle Scout and extend to him sincere best wishes for continued
6 success and happiness; and, be it further

7 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
8 prepared for Mr. Jackson as an expression of high regard by the
9 Texas House of Representatives.
