RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The team of Harvey Yates, Martin Yates III, Saint 2 Clair Peyton Yates, and John Yates is being inducted into the 3 Petroleum Hall of Fame on April 14, 2005, at the Petroleum Museum in 4 Midland; and

5 WHEREAS, The Petroleum Hall of Fame recognizes individuals 6 and teams who have made significant contributions to the 7 development of the petroleum industry and impacted their 8 communities through civic and social involvement; and

9 WHEREAS, For 75 years, the Yates brothers have developed oil 10 and gas properties in New Mexico, working collectively for Yates 11 Petroleum, while cultivating their own independent enterprises; 12 their father, Martin Yates, Jr., discovered the first commercial 13 oil well in the southeast corner of the state, and seven decades 14 later, the brothers have participated in some of the largest and 15 most significant fields in New Mexico; and

WHEREAS, After Harvey Yates made his first discovery in 1939, 16 he founded HEYCO, a drilling company with its headquarters in 17 Roswell; he was a board member of the Independent Petroleum 18 Association of America (IPAA) and the First National Bank of 19 Artesia and held offices in the Independent Petroleum Association 20 21 of New Mexico (IPANM), the Geological Society, the Boy Scouts, and 22 the Rotary Club; before his death in April 1999, he received the Independent Petroleum Association of Mountain States Wildcatter of 23 24 the Year award; and

1 WHEREAS, Harvey's younger brother, Martin Yates III, known as 2 Bitsy, started his own production company, MYCO, after he discovered a productive field in New Mexico with his father that 3 sparked a drilling boom; he worked with his brother, Saint Clair, as 4 5 a roustabout at Illinois Camp, north of Carlsbad, and the two men 6 eventually became successful independent operators, nicknamed the 7 Gold Dust Twins; Bitsy Yates was a member of IPAA and worked with 8 numerous oil companies as well as with the Artesia Little Theater 9 and the Artesia Broadcasting Company before his passing in 1985; 10 and

WHEREAS, Saint Clair Peyton Yates, known as S.P., perfected 11 12 air-drilling techniques at the Empire Abo field and worked with his brother, John, discovering a technique to handle the overproduction 13 14 of water in the Dagger Draw wells; he successfully drilled hundreds 15 of wells and, in 1959, founded Yates Drilling Company, which he now serves as vice president and director; until 1988, he served as 16 17 president of Yates Petroleum, and now works as the company's chair and director; and 18

WHEREAS, The persistence and determination of John Ashby 19 Yates in his quest to find oil enabled operators to learn how to 20 21 produce oil from the water-laden reservoir of Dagger Draw field, which in turn led to the growth of Yates Petroleum in the late 1980s 22 23 and the 1990s; he has served on the National Petroleum Council and 24 is a member of the New Mexico Oil and Gas Association, IPANM, the 25 American Petroleum Institute, the Roswell Geological Society, and 26 IPAA, which named him its Chief Roughneck of the Year; he has also 27 been inducted into the All American Wildcatters Association; and

1 WHEREAS, The Yates brothers' achievements as industry and 2 community leaders have distinguished them among the members of 3 their profession, and they are indeed deserving of this prestigious 4 award; now, therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas 6 Legislature hereby honor the team of Harvey Yates, Martin Yates 7 III, Saint Clair Peyton Yates, and John Yates on its induction into 8 the Petroleum Hall of Fame and recognize its members' outstanding 9 professional accomplishments and civic contributions; and, be it 10 further

11 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be 12 prepared for members of the Yates family as an expression of high 13 regard by the Texas House of Representatives.
