2 talents to benefit the larger community make the world a better
3 place through their actions and their example, and Joe V. Boerner,
4 Jr., of Lubbock is one such person; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of San Antonio, Mr. Boerner moved to
6 Lubbock after earning his law degree from The University of Texas at
7 Austin in 1958, and since that time he has distinguished himself as
8 a leader in the community; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. Boerner made his reputation as a partner at the
10 firm of Crenshaw, Dupree & Milam before forming his own law firm,
11 Boerner & Dennis, in 1993; and

12 WHEREAS, Highly esteemed by his professional peers, Mr.
13 Boerner is a former director of both the Lubbock County Junior Bar
14 Association and the Lubbock County Senior Bar Association and has
15 served on the State Bar of Texas Forms Committee; and

16 WHEREAS, His intelligence and integrity have made him much
17 sought after as an advisor to organizations and institutions, and
18 he has served as director of the Lubbock Club, the Lubbock Urban
19 Renewal Commission, and the South Plains Guidance Center, as a
20 trustee of the Lubbock Regional Mental Health & Mental Retardation
21 Center, and as a member of the Lubbock State School Public
22 Responsibility Committee; and

23 WHEREAS, A charter member of the Associated Republicans of
24 Texas, he is well known for his active interest in political life,

1 and he was voted the Outstanding Republican of Lubbock County in
2 1985; and

3 WHEREAS, His love of young people finds expression in both
4 his civic activities, such as his past directorship of Lubbock
5 Little League and Pony League, and his close relationship with his
6 seven grandchildren, who over the years have taken great delight in
7 their grandfather's signature "Black Buzzard" stories; and

8 WHEREAS, Mr. Boerner takes pride and pleasure in his family,
9 especially in Linda, his loving wife of 25 years, and in his
10 children, Rebecca Jones, Joseph Victor Boerner III, and John
11 Gregory Boerner; and

12 WHEREAS, Though it is impossible to gauge the full effect of a
13 man's life, some individuals leave their unmistakable mark on the
14 world as they move through it, and Joe Boerner's contributions to
15 his community continue to resonate in the lives of all who know him;
16 now, therefore, be it

18 Legislature hereby honor Joe V. Boerner, Jr., for his many efforts
19 in behalf of his fellow Texans; and, be it further
