1 WHEREAS, Sandra Reed is retiring as superintendent of the
2 Sharyland Independent School District on June 30, 2005, drawing to
3 a close an outstanding career in education; and

4 WHEREAS, A Chicago native, Ms. Reed earned her master's
5 degree at Texas A&M University and her doctorate at The University
6 of Texas at Austin; after teaching for nearly a decade, she worked
7 as an administrator in the Georgetown and Brazosport Independent
8 School Districts as well as for the Texas Education Agency and
9 Region IV Education Service Center in Houston; and

10 WHEREAS, Ms. Reed became the Sharyland ISD superintendent in
11 1995; during her notable tenure, five new elementary schools and a
12 junior high school have been built and the district has boosted
13 academic achievement, earning a "recognized" rating from the Texas
14 Education Agency; moreover, her commitment to the strict
15 enforcement of the school district's Student Code of Conduct has
16 ensured area students safer campuses where they can remain focused
17 on learning; and

18 WHEREAS, The longest-serving superintendent in the
19 district's history, Ms. Reed has set and maintained high standards
20 for the district, earning the lasting respect of her fellow
21 citizens, and it is a pleasure to commend her for her exemplary
22 tenure as she embarks on this exciting new chapter in her life; now,
