R E S O L U T I O N

1           WHEREAS, The Matagorda County Teen Court is an important  
2 alternative sentencing program for young people that enables those  
3 who have been convicted of a Class C misdemeanor to have the offense  
4 dismissed if they successfully complete the program; consisting of  
5 a trial by their peers, young people receive constructive  
6 sentencing requiring them to engage in community service,  
7 participate on a teen court jury, write letters of apology to  
8 victims, perform restitution, or enroll in a counseling program;  
9 and

10           WHEREAS, The program benefits from the interest and  
11 involvement of Texas Youth Court Advocates, a group of hard-working  
12 youth volunteers who complete training to act as attorneys, jurors,  
13 clerks, and bailiffs in the teen court setting; members of TYCA  
14 target high-risk youth offenders and take a personal interest in  
15 their cases, playing an active role in helping them to take personal  
16 responsibility for their actions and rectify the wrongs they have  
17 committed, and sending them a clear message that people their own  
18 age don't agree with their actions; and

19           WHEREAS, Those individuals who dedicate their time and  
20 talents to benefit the Matagorda County Teen Court program are  
21 performing an invaluable public service, and it is most appropriate  
22 that their good work be recognized; now, therefore, be it

23           RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas  
24 Legislature hereby honor the Matagorda County Teen Court program
