1 WHEREAS, Since its inception, the Texas Federation of College
2 Republicans has endeavored to inspire a new generation of political
3 leaders; and

4 WHEREAS, The TFCR is an organization composed of college
5 students who are determined and passionate about furthering the
6 conservative cause and supporting the Republican Party of Texas;
