RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, Dr. James Stewart Leeves of Naples retired from his 2 medical practice in December 2004, after rendering more than half a 3 century of exemplary care to the residents of Morris County; and

WHEREAS, Born in Naples on October 29, 1924, Dr. Leeves graduated from The University of Texas at Austin, received his medical degree from the UT Medical Branch at Galveston in 1947, and completed his internship in Iowa City, Iowa; and

8 WHEREAS, In October 1948, Dr. Leeves opened the David 9 Granberry Memorial Hospital in his hometown, in collaboration with 10 Dr. Charles Wise; together with a third partner, Dr. William King, 11 the pair established the East Texas Clinic in 1959 and, except for a 12 brief attempt at retirement in 1991, Dr. Leeves continued to 13 practice there for the next 45 years; and

14 WHEREAS, This esteemed physician has won widespread admiration not only for his professional accomplishments but also 15 for his civic leadership; a former trustee with the Pewitt 16 Consolidated Independent School District and coach of the Pewitt 17 18 Brahma football team, he is a lifelong member of the First United Methodist Church, which he presently serves as treasurer and 19 finance committee member; moreover, with his wife, Peggy, he 20 21 founded the Pewitt CISD Education Foundation, for which he is the newly elected board president; and 22

23 WHEREAS, Dr. Leeves has been justly recognized for his many 24 good works with a number of accolades; these have included

WHEREAS, Throughout his career, Dr. James Stewart Leeves has exemplified the highest ideals of the medical profession, and he has earned a special place in the hearts of countless individuals for his myriad contributions to the quality of life in Naples and the surrounding area; now, therefore, be it
