WHEREAS, Mrs. Cox began her professional life working for the Civil Aeronautics Administration but was soon invited to join the speech-drama faculty at what is now The University of Texas at Arlington (UTA); during her nearly 50-year tenure there, she developed speech and drama classes, taught English, and directed plays, all-college revues, and the Coronation of the King and Queen of the Student Body; while her university career flourished, she also served as a speech consultant to numerous businesses and managed a murder mystery troupe that performs in clubs and at parties; and
