R E S O L U T I O N

2 console the family and friends of Crisanta Garcia Lopez, who died on
3 March 21, 2005, at the age of 93; and

4 WHEREAS, Born on April 3, 1911, in Agualeguas, Nuevo Leon,
5 Mexico, Mrs. Lopez was the last survivor of 18 children born to
6 Nazario Hinojosa Garcia and Margarita Perez Garza; and

7 WHEREAS, A 63-year resident of Robstown, she attended Saint
8 Anthony's Catholic Church and belonged to the Catholic Daughters of
9 America, American G.I. Forum, and Senior Citizens Organization; she
10 became interested in politics in the 1950s and was an active worker
11 in many campaigns for Democratic candidates; she was also the
12 recipient of the 6th Annual Honorary Historian Award presented by
13 the Robstown Area Historical Commission; and

14 WHEREAS, A loving and inspirational matriarch to a large
15 family, Mrs. Lopez played a positive role in the lives of those
16 individuals who were fortunate enough to have known her, and her
17 spirit will continue to live in their hearts; now, therefore, be it
