WHEREAS, As an artist, Ms. Garza has enjoyed numerous solo exhibitions at prestigious institutions across the country, including the Hirshhorn Museum and Sculpture Garden of the Smithsonian Institution in Washington, D.C., the Whitney Museum of American Art in New York, the Smith College Museum of Art in Northampton, Massachusetts, and the Mexican Museum in San Francisco; in 1991, she had a major solo exhibition, titled "A Piece of My Heart/Pedacito de mi Corazon" that originated at Laguna Gloria Art Museum in Austin and eventually traveled to six other
