10 Kerrville, Jack Furman was a man of deeply felt faith who was

12 City Council and was both mayor pro tem and mayor of Kerrville; he

16 was a longtime member of the Kerrville Rotary Club; and

18 respected leader in his community, and he will be deeply missed by  
19 all those who were privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
