1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives is pleased to
2 welcome the World Relay of the Women's Global Charter for Humanity
3 to the Lone Star State; and

4 WHEREAS, Organizers of the World March of Women joined
5 together in Kigali, Rwanda, on December 10, 2004, to adopt the
6 Women's Global Charter for Humanity, a proposal that seeks to build
7 a world where exploitation, oppression, intolerance, and exclusion
8 no longer exist, and where integrity, diversity, and the rights and
9 freedoms of all are respected; and

10 WHEREAS, Beginning on March 8, 2005, an event known as the
11 World Relay is passing the charter through more than 50 countries,
12 with the final stop occurring in Africa on October 17, 2005; the
13 march arrives in the El Paso area on April 27, 2005, providing an
14 opportunity for local residents to learn more about this
15 outstanding initiative; and

16 WHEREAS, The Rio Bravo Healthy Communities Council, which
17 seeks to empower, create, and nurture programs that raise the
18 quality of life for residents living in the binational border
19 region, is supporting this noble effort in Texas; and

20 WHEREAS, It is truly a pleasure to honor all those who have
21 lent their time and talents to furthering the cause of equality,
22 freedom, solidarity, justice, and peace through this important
23 project; now, therefore, be it
