R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Texas Highway Patrol Trooper Chris Frost of
2 Waxahachie recently demonstrated immense fortitude when he saved
3 the life of his neighbor's nine-month-old son; and

4 WHEREAS, The incident occurred when Trooper Frost was off
5 duty and received an urgent knock on his front door; on answering,
6 he found his neighbor holding his infant son, who was choking on a
7 swallowed object; Trooper Frost quickly sprang into action, and
8 although it was the first time that he had been called on to handle
9 this type of emergency, he expertly administered a life-saving
10 procedure; he was then able to retrieve the object from the infant's
11 mouth, and the child soon recovered; and

12 WHEREAS, With a father who served as a police chief for 17
13 years, Chris Frost began riding with troopers at age 18; at the
14 start of his career, he served for four years with the McGregor
15 Police Department before applying to the Texas Department of Public
16 Safety's training academy; on graduation, he was assigned to Ellis
17 County, where he served first on the east side of the district
18 before moving to his current base in Waxahachie; and

19 WHEREAS, Trooper Frost has been justly nominated to receive a
20 top award from his agency, the Director's Citation, for his calm and
21 confident response to this critical situation; his swift actions
22 saved the life of a child and reflect the work of a talented and
23 caring professional; now, therefore, be it
