1 WHEREAS, Residents of Del Rio were deeply saddened by the
2 loss of a beloved educator and friend on August 10, 2003, with the
3 passing of Ronnie McFadin, at the age of 61; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of West Texas, Mr. McFadin was raised in
5 Iraan and graduated from Sul Ross State University in 1965; he began
6 his teaching career at Centennial School and coached Alpine seventh
7 and eighth grade teams, and he later joined the faculty at Alpine
8 High School; and

9 WHEREAS, Mr. McFadin went on to hold a distinguished tenure
10 in Del Rio, serving as a vocational agriculture teacher and coach
11 until his retirement in 2002; and

12 WHEREAS, This devoted husband's and father's love of teaching
13 was surpassed only by his love of family; a man of integrity and a
14 true asset to the educational community, Ronnie McFadin is greatly
15 missed, but his memory lives on in the hearts of the many people
16 whose lives he touched; now, therefore, be it

18 Legislature hereby pay special tribute to the life of Ronnie
19 McFadin and extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to
20 his wife, Karen; to his children; to his brothers; and to his other
