15 teaching, coaching, and administration, and his impact was felt in  
16 the Alpine, Van Horn, Ft. Hancock, El Paso, and Fabens school  
17 systems before he retired as the junior high school principal in  
18 Fabens in 1983; in addition to his professional duties, he enjoyed  
19 refereeing school sports; and

21 well as going out for coffee, Mr. Woodruff was a devoted husband and  
22 caring family man, and he is profoundly missed by his family members
