WHEREAS, Throughout the years, the Lone Star State's rich 1 2 cultural heritage has produced a remarkable variety of artists and 3 craftsmen, and these talented Texans deserve our deepest gratitude and admiration; Charles William Shaw is one such artist, and it is 4 appropriate at this time to recognize his many contributions to the 5 6 fields of art and literature in Texas; and WHEREAS, Born in Austin in 1941, Charley Shaw graduated from 7 Travis High School and went on to study life drawing for three years 8 with the illustrator Malcolm Thurgood; and 9 WHEREAS, Typical subjects for this accomplished artist are 10 11

Texas frontier lifestyles and historical scenes, children, and musicians, and his preferred mediums are watercolors and oils; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Shaw has produced hundreds of illustrations of historical subjects for books, brochures, and articles over a span of more than 45 years; he was commissioned by The University of Texas Press to draw 248 images for the first edition of James Michener's two-volume historical epic, Texas; he wrote and illustrated Indian Life in Texas, and he recently published illustrations for From a Watery Grave: The Discovery and Excavation of La Salle's Shipwreck, La Belle; his work also appears in numerous children's books, including Little Johnny Raindrop, That's What Love Is, and the Walt Disney Davy Crockett series; and

WHEREAS, In addition to his book illustrations, this gifted artist has produced a collection of paintings depicting the Texas
