R E S O L U T I O N

1 School in 1888, W. H. Adamson High School was annexed by the Dallas
2 Independent School District in 1904 and acquired its present name
3 in 1935 following the death of its namesake, a distinguished
4 educator who served area students for three decades; the school's
5 numerous accomplished alumni include such well-known Texans as
6 former U.S. Speaker of the House Jim Wright, singers Ray Wylie
7 Hubbard and Stevie Ray Vaughan, Congressional Medal of Honor
8 recipient Samuel David Dealey, astronaut Donald Lee Holmquest, and
9 the first Miss Teenage America, Brenda Broadnax; and

10 WHEREAS, The Texas Capitol is an ideal setting for young and
11 old alike to explore the rich past of the Lone Star State and to gain
12 insight into the workings of our state legislature, and it is a
13 pleasure to welcome these students at this time; now, therefore, be
