1 WHEREAS, Public-spirited women from throughout the Lone Star
2 State are gathering in Austin to celebrate the Texas Federation of
3 Republican Women Legislative Day at the Capitol on April 14, 2005,
4 and this occasion provides a fitting opportunity to recognize the
5 myriad contributions of those individuals present on this day from
6 the Dallas County Council; and
