1 WHEREAS, Those Texans who demonstrate great courage in
2 emergency situations are truly deserving of our admiration and
3 gratitude, and Gloria Ramos of El Paso is one such individual; and

4 WHEREAS, On January 24, 2005, Ms. Ramos heard a loud crash
5 outside her home and on investigating found a police patrol vehicle
6 on fire; and

7 WHEREAS, Seeing that Officer Calvin Green was trapped inside
8 the car, Ms. Ramos braved the flames to help the badly injured
9 officer free himself before calling the emergency in and returning
10 to the scene with her own water hose to help douse the burning
11 vehicle; and

12 WHEREAS, This selfless act of heroism gave the law
13 enforcement officer a stronger chance of survival, and in acting as
14 she did, Ms. Ramos distinguished herself as a remarkable member of
15 her community and earned recognition from the El Paso Area Chapter
16 of the American Red Cross; now, therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
18 Legislature hereby honor Gloria Ramos for her heroism and extend to
19 her sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further

20 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
21 prepared for Ms. Ramos as an expression of high regard by the Texas
22 House of Representatives.
