R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Ouisa Davis has been a tireless advocate of the  
2 immigrant population of El Paso and has aided countless individuals  
3 in becoming United States citizens; and

4 WHEREAS, This notable Texan currently serves as an attorney  
5 and the executive director of Diocesan Migrant and Refugee  
6 Services, an agency of the Catholic Diocese of El Paso that is  
7 dedicated to providing assistance to those attempting to navigate  
8 the often complicated and costly immigration and citizenship  
9 processes; and

11 Diocesan Migrant and Refugee Services is able to help 5,000  
12 families a year, offering much needed counsel and legal
