8 the Capital City, where she enjoyed seeing movies and trolley rides
9 to Deep Eddy; and

10 WHEREAS, Mrs. House moved with her mother to Austin during
11 World War I, after her brothers left the family farm to serve their
12 country; she found employment as a long distance operator, riding a
13 streetcar to work each day; and

14 WHEREAS, On May 29, 1920, she married the love of her life,
15 Eugene Preston House, with whom she shared more than 30 years, and
16 the couple were blessed with four children, Rosa Jo, Ella Mae,
17 Wilbur Darrel, and Edna Earle; and

18 WHEREAS, Today the matriarch of a large family, Mrs. House
19 continues to enjoy the love and affection of her daughter, Rosa Jo,
20 as well as 11 grandchildren, 14 great-grandchildren, and five
21 great-great-grandchildren; and

22 WHEREAS, She treasures her faith, and is a long-time valued
23 congregant of the First Baptist Church in Elgin and a member of the
24 Baptist Women's Missionary; and

1 WHEREAS, For more than a century, this gracious lady has
2 brought joy and happiness to the countless people whose lives she
3 has touched, and she has earned the lasting respect and admiration
4 of all who are privileged to know her; now, therefore, be it
